1. The referenced letter pointed out an existing violation at Installation Restoration Site 2, Magazine Road Landfill. Last year's heavy rains and the recent rains have removed a portion of the landfill cover, thereby, exposing the waste directly to the Borrego Canyon Wash in violation of the California Water Code.

2. We are requesting a CERCLA Removal Action (less than six months) be implemented for Site 2. The Removal Action shall include a permanent repair to the washed out areas and properly capping the landfill for closure according to state regulations. All construction is to be completed no later than 1 Nov 93.

3. We are also informing Mr. John Broderick of the Regional Water Quality Control Board of this request (encl). If further information is needed, please contact Chrisa Mitchell, Environmental Department, at DSN 997-6607.
