The Division of Health Assessment and Consultation (DHAC), Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), has completed its public health assessment of El Toro Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS), Santa Ana, California, dated April 7, 1993. The data and information in the MCAS Public Health Assessment have been evaluated, and ATSDR has placed MCAS in the category of indeterminant public health hazard. That category is used to designate sites for which there is incomplete information.

The Public Health Action Plan (PHAP) contained in the public health assessment describes actions to be taken by ATSDR and/or other government agencies designed to identify, mitigate, and prevent adverse human health effects resulting from exposures to hazardous substances in the environment. As new environmental, toxicologic, or health outcome data become available, ATSDR would like to review that information. ATSDR will annually review new information and update the PHAP plan for MCAS.
