FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT
EL TORO, CALIFORNIA

THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY HAS SIGNED AN AGREEMENT (A FEDERAL FACILITY AGREEMENT) WITH THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA), CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES, CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD TO CLEANUP GROUNDWATER AND SOIL CONTAMINATION AT MARINE CORPS AIR STATION, EL TORO, CALIFORNIA.

MARINE CORPS AIR STATION EL TORO WILL CONDUCT THE NECESSARY STUDIES AND APPROPRIATE CLEANUP ACTIVITIES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF EPA AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA PURSUANT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE, COMPENSATION AND LIABILITY ACT (CERCLA) OF 1980 (MORE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS SUPERFUND) AND THE SUPERFUND AMMENDMENTS AND REAUTHORIZATION ACT (SARA) OF 1986.
