We are in the process of evaluating historical aerial photograph anomaly (APHO) sites at the Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro, and we have submitted several Summary Reports to the Base Realignment and Closure Cleanup Team (BCT) during the summer of 1999. We have received written concurrence from the State of California, Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control on our No Further Action (NFA) recommendations for the seventeen (17) APHO sites listed on the attached Table.
