Minutes of the El Toro Advisory Committee

August 25, 1999

The committee was called to order by Marcia Rudolph. All attendees introduced themselves. (List Appended). The minutes for the past few meetings were not discussed. They are pending. As soon as they are complete, they will be distributed to all committee members.

New Business

Marcia indicated the following activities had occurred since the last meeting:

- Talked with Ms. Pat Broudy with the Atomic Veterans' organization. Received an e-mail from veteran who worked at El Toro 1957. He was associated with Atomic Tests but was stationed at MCAS El Toro
- Received two phone calls on depleted U238 in bunkers from personnel from the Dept. of Fish and Wildlife stationed in Alaska
- Reviewed minutes on Alton Parkway Extension Project meeting
- Learned that the 1000 foot buffer for Landfill No. 2 does not apply to the Alton Parkway Extension according to the Alton Parkway Working group Status Report dated 5/27/99

Gail indicated that the following activities had taken place since our last meeting:

- Wrote letter to Peter Melia with the FAA concerning the development of the land to be turned over by El Toro. Specifically she requested clarification on a number of issues, such as development of 200 acres by FAA, etc. No response to date.
- Obtained copies of relevant portions of Title 41 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 101 dealing with transfers of property within the federal government and the required documentation which needs to be provided to the GSA (General Services Administration).
- Trying to obtain a copy of a "Draft Interim Technical memorandum" on Tustin. The report discusses the water contamination issue at Tustin
- Trying to obtain a copy of the University of Chicago Study which was done on Tustin regarding the useability of groundwater under Tustin and El Toro

Marcia reported that reviews of the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board files concerning the wastewater treatment plant at El Toro indicated that files were non-existent. Local staff have tried to find the files both locally and in Sacramento and have not been successful. Other files for the period concerning El Toro are available. There appears to be some gaps in the files however.

Other information discussed:

- A representative from the Saddleback Valley School District has requested to be appointed to the RAB. Also, the Irvine School District may want to be represented as well.
- A meeting will be held on Thursday, August 26, 1999, with Paul Eckles of ETRPA to strategize future activities.

Motion was made to have everyone ready to discuss specific topics/questions based on a review of the March 1999 Base Closure Plan (BCP). This document is updated yearly. A copy was prepared for circulation and excerpts (Executive Summary and Chapter 5) were distributed to all present. The committee needs to focus topics and questions to be addressed in the next version that is scheduled to be issued in March 2000. Possible issues/topics include: revised timeline, perchlorate and MtBE, radionuclides such as Radium 226 and depleted Uranium 238, Unexploded Ordinance (UXO) at Landfill Site 1, installation of lysimeters around Landfill sites, appropriate soil-gas models used at Landfill Site 2, GSA requirements for land transfers between MCAS and other governmental entities. .

The next Technical Review Committee meeting is scheduled for September 8, 1999. The next RAB meeting will be Wednesday, September 29, 1999, at Irvine City Hall Meeting room.


Subject: MINUTES OF ELTORO ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETINGS
