Dear Mr. Nuzum,

I have completed a review of both the Federal Facilities Agreement and the minutes provided to me by CH2M Hill of the October 26 Technical Review Committee meeting at El Toro. I regret that I was unable to attend that meeting. I was out of town at a conference that was scheduled many months in advance of the Technical Review Committee meeting.

I want to comment on item #11 in the minutes. It is stated that the deadline for submittal of comments on the draft documents is December 1, 1990. I should like to point out that the Federal Facilities Agreement specifically requires a 60 day public comment period from the date of signing. Documents were signed October 24, 1990, which makes the 60 day comment period end on December 24, 1990. Since this is a holiday, I would assume that the comment period would extend to the 26th. However, the comment period must extend well into the month of December, regardless of whether the holidays are counted or not. I have sent my comments on the FFA to Lt. Jg Rehor at the El Toro base. I am attaching a copy of my comments for you.

I note that the TRC meeting will be held in January or February. I am most anxious to be able to attend. Therefore, I would like to provide you with some information about my schedule so that I may have the most opportunity of attending the meeting. I will again be out of town from January 16 through January 18 at a previously scheduled conference. I am committed to a week long program from January 28 through February 1. During the month of February, I have a commitment for all day long every Wednesday. I would request that, if possible, you accommodate me by avoiding these dates for scheduling the upcoming meeting. I regretted having to miss the October meeting. It is the first one of the Technical Review Committee meetings that I have been unable to
