Dear Mr. Wybenga:

Section 403.12(p) of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations requires that your agency, EPA, and the California Department of Health Services be notified by February 23, 1991 if more than 15 kilograms per month of non-acute hazardous waste (HW) (or any acute HW) is discharged into the sewer system. This notification does not apply to pollutants already reported under self-monitoring requirements.

To the best of our knowledge, notification under the above regulations is not required for either Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) El Toro or MCAS Tustin.
