With your support, we continue to proceed with our evaluation of the historical aerial photograph anomaly (APHO) sites at the Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro. In addition, we have received written concurrence from the State of California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control, on our No Further Action (NFA) recommendations for the twenty (20) APHO sites listed on the enclosed table.

We would appreciate a response from your agency on these issues within 90 days of receipt of this letter. Should you elect not to respond in writing during this time frame, we will assume that you concur with our, and DTSC's position, and we will identify NFA status for these APHO sites in the next Base Realignment and Closure Business Plan update.
