The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has reviewed your letter dated August 2, 2000, proposing a schedule for Remedial Design activities at IRP Sites 2 & 17. Your letter also contained a request to consolidate the "Construction Quality (QA) Assurance Plan" with the "Construction Quality Control (QC) Plan" into a single QA/QC Plan, and, incorporate the "Contingency Plan" into the "Operation and Maintenance (O&M) Plan".

USEPA approves your proposed schedule and the consolidation of the QA and QC Plans. However, before we can approve the incorporation of the Contingency Plan into the O&M Plan, there will need to be an approved Contingency Plan prior to the commencement of construction activities at the landfills.
