Subj: Temporary Accumulation Area (TAA) 800
Former Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro

Transmitted is supplementary information pertaining to TAA 800 (Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 229) at the former Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro. TAA 800 is located in the southwestern section of the facility, within the investigation boundary of Installation Restoration Program Site 24. We collected additional soil samples from TAA 800 in January 2003 in response to DTSC comments dated 31 October 2002. We presented the new field information with a revised screening risk evaluation in the attached Addendum. The excess cancer risk for residential use is less than 10^{-6} and the Hazard Index for residential use is less than 1.

Based upon the evaluation of the new information, we recommend designating no further action status for TAA 800 (SWMU 229) and environmental condition of property (ECP) category 3 in the next BRAC Business Plan update.

Please review the attachment and provide comments within 60 days of receipt, if possible. If we do not receive comments from your office by 27 May 2003, we will assume that you concur with our recommendation to designate no further action status for TAA 800. A formal transmittal letter may follow.
