	<p>The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the status of investigations at MCAS EI Toro and to invite comments and questions regarding draft versions of the RI/FS Work Plan (WP), Sampling and Analysis Plan (SAP), Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPP), and Community Relations Plan (CRP).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Introduction. LTJG Rehor opened the meeting and invited the attendees to introduce themselves and their affiliations. 2. Background on Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA). Walter Sandza described the FFA requirements under CERCLA. The purpose of the agreement is to set timetables for work phase completion. The participating Agencies have also agreed not to take separate legal action (outside of agreement provisions) for sites addressed under the FFA. Goals of the FFA include addressing RCRA issues. The document is now subject to 45-day public comment period; a copy is available at the Heritage Park Regional Library in Irvine. <p>The need for expedited removal actions will be determined as data are gathered and reviewed (August - September 1991).</p> <p>A TRC member commented that, in order to reassure the public, language should appear in the WP or FFA regarding the schedule of removal actions. EPA commented that with the continual nature of the assessment it would be difficult to provide such a schedule. In addition, completion dates for draft versions of major site-related documents are the only completion dates enforceable under the FFA.</p> <p>A TRC member pointed out that, although regulations call for beginning remediation within 15 months (of ROD), the WP schedule estimates an August 1993 ROD and</p>

The Agencies will consider the appropriateness of adding a cluster well between the easternmost washes.</p> <p>A representative of the Irvine Company said that space limitations might preclude locations of pump test wells. Several buildings have recently been added along Bee Channel. The well locations may have to be reverified.</p> <p>9. Extent of Investigation. EPA said that the investigation needs to proceed downgradient until no more contamination is detected. EPA currently considers all known contamination in the area to be part of the site. The Navy requested written clarification from the Agencies on this position. EPA noted that it can require the downgradient investigation whether or not the Base is considered to be the source of contamination. The OCWD considers the issue of tracing contamination to an exact source on-base to be academic, as long as the investigation can determine whether contamination can be attributed to the Base at the perimeter.</p> <p>10. Presentations. The TRC suggested that the presentation maps be revised to show sites under investigation, and have symbols more clearly distinguishable from each other.</p> <p>11. Comment Deadline. The deadline for submittal of comments on these draft documents by members of the TRC is 1 December 1990.</p> <p>12. Next Meeting. The next TRC meeting will probably be held in January or February 1991. Members will be notified when the date is set.</p>
