Subj: TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (TRC) MEETING *CTD # 18*

1. The TRC meeting began at 0930 hrs. on 26 April 1990 at MCAS El Toro. Persons and their affiliated organizations are listed in enclosure (1).

2. The meeting began with opening statements for Mike Rehor as to general facilities activities. Specifically Tank 398 was discussed along with a date of June 1990 to report findings in the currently underway study.

3. Walter Sandza presented a discussion of the Installation Restoration Program schedule. This discussion was generic and gave a general overview of the time frame required to complete each segment of the program. It was also noted that the first cut of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) would begin negotiations in late May 1990.

4. CH2MHILL introduced themselves to the TRC and gave a brief statement as to their status within the RI/FS Work Plan schedule. Plans proposed by CH2MHILL are as follows:

- o Possible VOC sources; sites 2, 3, 5 and 10.
- o Potentially all 21 sites to have groundwater monitoring.
- o Additional well clusters at critical depths and locations.
- o Other sites (beyond the recognized 22) to be studied under new PA.
- o Short and long term pump tests to be preformed as needed.
- o EPA has ruled out raceway.
- o Presentation of maps by CH2MHILL showing location of projected wells and their relations between existing wells and RI sites.
- o Presentation of general work to be completed on any site at El Toro.
- o Presentation of specific schedule for El Toro during the RI/FS Work Plan.

5. The meeting closed with a question and answer period.
