On March 24, 1988, the Officer in Charge of Construction, Southwest, forwarded a copy of the Confirmation Study work plan for Marine Corps Air Stations El Toro and Tustin to your office. In the accompanying letter, it was requested that any comments on the study be submitted by April 15, 1988. As of this date, your comments have not been received.

Understanding your workload and in the spirit of cooperation with the Board, I have delayed finalizing the work plan to enable your staff to forward comments. However, I must now proceed with the Confirmation Study and must assume your concurrence unless the Board's comments are received by July 20, 1988.

In addition, on March 31, 1988 I requested that the Board designate in writing one individual for the Technical Review Committee (TRC). As of this date, notification of the Board's representative has not been received. Although a Board representative did attend the first TRC meeting, a formal administrative record for our cleanup program is required. Your written designation would therefore be appreciated.
