
As requested in my May 28 fax memorandum to you, please review and provide concurrence or specific corrective comments on the Risk-Based Concentrations (RBCs) identified in Section 7 (preliminary baseline risk assessment) of the MCAS El Toro RI Phase 1 Technical Memo.

Even though you were not at the May 26/27 FFA Managers meeting, the urgency of this request was communicated to the representative EPA manager because RBCs are used in the initial stage of the DQO process for selecting the Chemicals of Potential Concern (COPC) that will be investigated in Phase 2 field work.

Since the RBCs are based on the most recent EPA risk guidance criteria, I ask that your comments be focused on where the development of the RBCs differ from EPA risk assessment policy. Please note that the State of California, DTSC, has also been asked to submit their comments for our consideration.
