Description of Discussion:

After reviewing the preliminary draft of the first Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) report (Site 13) submitted for MCAS El Toro, Juan Jimenez, Department of Toxic Substances Control, requested a site visit to all the sites currently proposed for removal action (Sites 4, 7, 11, 13, 14, 19, 20). The purpose of the meeting was to visit each site and to discuss site specific information relative to the preparation of the EE/CA.

Juan Jimenez, Karnig Ohannessian, and Scott Christopherson visited each site with the exception of Site 19. At each site, we identified the units of the site, the contaminants detected, and the general locations of the contaminants. We discussed the general strategy of the proposed removal procedure and the treatment technologies being evaluated.
