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SUMMARY REPORT FOR FORMER TEMPORARY ACCUMULATION AREA (TAA) 626, MARINE CORPS AIR STATION (MCAS) EL TORO

Dear Mr. Gould:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) reviewed the referenced document dated August 15, 2001. DTSC concurs with the recommended designation of no further action for TAA 626.

The report presents information pertaining to TAA 626, also known as Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 158. TAA 626 is located within the investigation boundary of Unit 4 of Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 20. IRP Site 20 is also known as the hobby shop located in the northwest quadrant of the Station. From approximately 1967 through early 1999, military personnel used the hobby shop to service and repair their privately-owned vehicles.

TAA 626 is a portable steel roof structure that could have been used at various locations within the hobby shop courtyard area. Based on photographs included in the *Final Marine Corps Air Station El Toro Hazardous Material/Hazardous Waste Management Plan* (Science Applications International Corporation, August 1994), drums were stored in portable secondary containment units beneath the portable steel structure.

The Draft Final Record of Decision [ROD], Operable Units 2A and 3A, No Action Sites, Marine Corps Air Station, El Toro, California (Bechtel National, Incorporated, September 1997) was signed by the Federal Facility Agreement signatories in

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September 1997. The ROD included a decision of no action for IRP Site 20 based on field investigations, laboratory analyses, and an assessment of potential human-health risks. As a result, DTSC concurs with the recommended designation of no further action for TAA 626. This can be documented in the next Base Realignment and Closure Business Plan Update.
