Submitted for your review is the Draft Fact Sheet, Installation Restoration Program Sites 3 and 5 Closure of Inactive Landfills, Former Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS), El Toro, California (Enclosure 1). The Draft Fact Sheet is intended to update the community on the upcoming capping of the landfills at Sites 3 and 5. The fact sheet provides a summary of the selected remedy and components of the landfill cover system. The Remedial Design/Remedial Action Contractor is currently identifying an off-station source for cover material. Once the source is identified, a map identifying truck routes adjacent to former MCAS El Toro will be prepared and the map will be incorporated into the next version of the Fact Sheet.
