Submitted for your review is the Draft Final Fact Sheet, Installation Restoration Program Sites 3 and 5 Closure of Inactive Landfills, Former Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS), El Toro, California (Enclosure 1). Enclosure 2 is the response to Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) comments on the Draft Fact Sheet submitted by DTSC in December 2008.
