Dear Mr. Dong:

In accordance with Section 25356.1 of the State of California Health and Safety Code, the Navy is required to develop and implement a Community Relations Plan as part of the remedial activities for Hunters Point Naval Shipyard. We have previously provided your office with our Department's specific guidelines for Community Relations Plans.

We request that the Navy begin initiation of this process immediately and submit a draft plan to us by May 1, 1987. A public meeting to discuss the results of the Verification Study and any other site characterization work should be included in the plan with a second public meeting for the Remedial Action Plan to be scheduled at a later date.

It is our understanding that the Navy has more than one Command which is involved with Community Relations decisions. Please advise us as to who is the principal contact for the Navy's development and implementation of a Community Relations Program.
