We are in the process of developing Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) work plans for the characterization of hazardous waste contamination at Ex-Hunters Point Naval Shipyard, San Francisco, California to comply with the requirements of Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended by Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA).

Before completing the proposed RI/FS work, we request that the City and County of San Francisco identify any requirements, standards, criteria, and/or limitations which it believes are legally applicable or relevant and appropriate to the Navy's response to the hazardous substances at Ex-Hunters Point Naval Shipyard under CERCLA, as amended by SARA. In order to incorporate your input into our workplan please identify in writing such applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements, standards, criteria, and/or limitations by November 2, 1987.

In your written response please provide citations of authority for any requirements, standards, criteria, and/or limitations you identify which are contained in Federal and/or State law and/or regulations. In addition, please provide us with copies of documents which set forth any standards, criteria, and/or limitations which are not contained in Federal or State law or regulations.
