1. Pearl Harbor submitted Volume I of the draft Historical Radiological Assessment (HRA) for Hunters Point Annex via reference (a) in January 1999. This HRA is intended to serve as a Preliminary Assessment (PA) for radionuclides under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), and addresses radiological operations associated with the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program (NNPP).

2. In reference (b) the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) stated that, based on the Department of Health Services (DHS) review of the HRA, the DTSC had no further comments for Volume I of the HRA.

3. In reference (c), EPA Region IX provided comments on Volume I of the Hunters Point Annex HRA. Pearl Harbor provided responses to these comments in reference (d). Reference (e) stated that EPA had no further comments on Volume I of the Hunters Point HRA.

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PROGRAM

4. A copy of the Final HRA, Volume I, is enclosed. This volume includes the original of spliced USGS maps of the region. A copy of the HRA, along with all correspondence concerning this HRA and the HRA references, will be distributed to the San Francisco Main Public Library and the Anna E. Waden Public Library for public information. The Navy will inform the Hunters Point Restoration Advisory Board of the availability of the HRA at an upcoming meeting.
