**REVISED SCOPING DOCUMENT - HUNTERS POINT ANNEX**

We have reviewed the Navy's response to the Department's comments on the draft Scoping Document and the revised Scoping Document dated March 3, 1988.

Based on the proposed actions described in the Navy's response and revisions made to the draft document, the Department hereby approves the Scoping Document with the following conditions:

1. The proposed comprehensive investigation, as described in the response to the Department's comment 1C, should also include all areas that were accessible to the Triple A Machine Shop or any other lessee. The lack of any record of improper disposal activities by the lessees should not, in and of itself, be used as a basis for eliminating any areas from further investigation.
2. A detailed sewer testing program should be included in the scope of RI/FS workplan. This program should be designed to investigate potential contamination of soil and groundwater by industrial wastewater via sewer leaks.
