We have completed our review of the Solid Waste Air Assessment Test Plan (SWAT Plan) submitted for the Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex in accordance with the requirements of California Air Resources Board (C.A.R.B.) "Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Testing Guidelines" (January 23, 1988). This letter is our approval of this plan subject to the following conditions:

Integrated Surface Samples (I.S.S.):

The Integrated Surface Samples must be analyzed for total organics (as methane) and for the "Specified Air Contaminants" (Air Detection Limits) shown on Attachment 2 of the guidelines.

Gas Migration Testing:

These samples must be analyzed for the Attachment 2 compounds as well as for total organics (as methane) at co-disposal areas.


The California State Health and Safety Code, Section 41805.5(a) required S.W.A.T. reports to be submitted to this District on or before

July 1, 1987. The C.A.R.B. must receive this data from us by January 1, 1989 in order to prepare their report for the State Legislature due by July 1, 1989. Allowing a reasonable time for our review of these reports, we must receive this S.W.A.T. report on or before December 31, 1988.
