
Dear Mr. Hatayama;

Enclosed please find the Navy's Final Community Relations Plan for the Installation Restoration Program at Hunters Point Annex, Naval Station Treasure Island. This Plan has been prepared pursuant to all requirements contained in the Remedial Action Order HSA 87/88-034RA, as well as all relevant federal and state laws and regulations. As you are aware, this Plan is the product of five separate community meetings, numerous community interviews and several meetings with your staff. All of the items discussed in your letter dated October 7, 1988 have been incorporated into this final plan, as have comments from the Environmental Protection Agency.

I am pleased to inform you that as a result of this extensive public involvement process, the Navy has embarked upon a first-of-its-kind environmental outreach program. This is evidence of the Navy's full commitment to the community relations process, and the Navy's recognition of the unique circumstances the Bayview/Hunters Point community present.
