Dear Mr. Brennon:

This letter is to confirm our November 29, 1988 telephone conversation regarding the Solid Waste Air Quality Assessment Test (SWAQAT) for Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex (HPA).

The SWAQAT for HPA involves collecting Ambient Air (AA) samples for 10 non-consecutive 24-hour periods and analyzing them for the "Calderon Air Contaminants." A prerequisite for collecting AA samples is that measurable precipitation cannot have fallen at the site 72-hours prior to sampling. To this date, six AA samples have been collected at HPA; the four remaining AA samples have not been collected as a result of precipitation during November 1988.

As discussed, with weather permitting, we anticipate submission of the draft SWAQAT report for your review and comment in January 1989.
