Based on our review of the draft Data Management Plan for Hunters Point Annex, we hereby grant conditional approval of the Data Management Plan. Final approval of this plan will be contingent on adequately addressing the following deficiencies:

1. Section 4.1 of the Data Management Plan does not discuss any potential corrective measures, to be implemented upon the discovery of incomplete or inaccurate data. This section should include a contingency plan for corrective measures.
2. Section 4.1.3 does not discuss the role of DHS in the review and approval of documents. Since the Department plays an integral part in the review process, discussion of the Department's role should be included in this section.

Please revise this document and submit the final draft by March 10, 1989.
