**SAMPLING ANALYSIS FOR SOIL SAMPLES AT SITE IR-8; BUILDING 503, PCB
SPILL SITE**

This letter is a follow-up to a request made by Harding Lawson and Associates (HLA) on 10 October 1989 to modify the Sampling Plan for Group II Sites, Hunters Point Annex.

HLA identified that the 3 foot samples collected within the "PCB footprint" are in clean fill material placed at the site after prior excavation of PCB contaminated soil. HLA requested that sampling analysis be conducted for PCBs only, not the analyses identified in the Group II Sampling Plan.

After careful consideration and based on previous sampling results from the site, the Department agrees to allow sampling analysis for PCBs only. This approval only applies to the 3 foot samples within the fill material at site IR-8.
