TO: REVIEW CHAIN

Significant points of attached report:

- University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) parcel was formerly Navy owned and part of Hunters Point Annex (HPA).
- UCSF parcel is adjacent to HPA IR-1, Industrial Landfill.
- Underlying soils are probably not landfill but soils and groundwater have been impacted by chemicals.
- The source of these chemicals is unknown.
- Report has been briefed to UCSF. Navy position is that we do not plan additional work on their site.
- Expect UCSF to respond with request we study and clean-up. UCSF will maintain low public visibility due to nature of business. (ANIMAL RESEARCH)
- EPA and DOHS know report is on its way.
- Additional work is required and Federal Government/UCSF/Regulators will all be involved.
