Dear Mr. Hatayama:

In accordance with the Remedial Action Order (Docket No. HSA87/88-034RA) for Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex, and as discussed on February 13, 1990 with Mark Malinowski of your staff and at the agency meeting on February 21, 1990, the Navy requests time extensions on the due dates for the following items:

1. Group II, Primary Investigation

Resumption of field work in March instead of February.

Preliminary evaluation of the chemical and hydrogeologic data for these sites is in progress. The data will be more fully evaluated once it is loaded into the database systems.

Loading of the data has been delayed due to the incompatibility of the data disk format supplied by the laboratories and the format specified to the laboratories by our contractor. Our contractor is working closely with the labs to correct the disk and they are also examining methods to maintain the overall schedule despite this problem.

2. PA/SI, Triple A Sites

Incorporation of agency review comments (2 sites) into the SI Workplan - 21 March 1990

Incorporation of agency review comments (5 sites) into the RI Workplans - 5 April 1990

Incorporating agency review comments requires a significant departure from the SI approach which the Navy and its contractor had proposed in our draft submittal.
