1. This is to inform you of several technical corrections to the Community Relations Plan for the environmental clean-up of Hunters Point Annex, Naval Station, Treasure Island.
2. The terms "draft Remedial Action Plan (RAP)" and Final RAP are used throughout the Community Relations Plan. These are terms used under California law, and not federal law. Draft RAP is the same as "Proposed Plan" under federal law. Final RAP is the same as "Record of Decision" under federal law.
3. A corrected Table 1 of the Community Relations Plan is attached. Under Item 9, a Responsiveness Summary will not be prepared for the Draft Remedial Design, but will be prepared for the Final RAP (or Record of Decision under federal law).
