Dear Mr. Powell:

In accordance with Section 7.7(b) of the Hunters Point Annex Federal Facility Agreement, EPA is hereby notifying the Navy that we are extending the comment period on the Environmental Sampling and Analysis Plan (ESAP) for Hunters Point Annex, dated August 28, 1990, by thirty days. We will provide comments to the Navy on this document no later than November 14, 1990.

Because the ESAP is one of the first such plans addressing potential contamination from a complex Superfund site on San Francisco Bay, a number of federal agencies as well as specialists within EPA are concerned that a comprehensive review be conducted. This extension is needed to allow sufficient time for such a comprehensive review.

The extension will also allow for discussion of the ESAP at the October 25 meeting of the Environmental Assessment Group (EAG) at Fort Cronkite. As I mentioned to you recently, the EAG is a forum for specialists from a variety of environmental and natural resource agencies to discuss environmental assessment activities at Superfund Sites throughout Region 9. The EAG meetings have proven helpful in clarifying issues and providing guidance in the conduct of environmental assessments.
