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Hi Keith,

I have reviewed the changes noted in the Draft Final Parcels D-1 and G Groundwater Treatability Study Technical Report, IR-09, IR-33, and IR-71, Hunters Point Shipyard, San Francisco, CA. I have one minor comment.

A few times in the report, Paragraph 3 on Page 35 for example, the following sentence appears:

"A secondary purpose of the SVRA is to provide an assessment of the current human health risks from vapor intrusion by accounting for ZVI and treatment and incorporating data from the soil vapor sampling conducted under the GWTS."

Since all the evaluated exposure pathways are not currently complete (site is not re-developed), I would change the wording for the phrase "current human health risks" to something like "potential human health risks based on current soil vapor concentrations."

Also, while the BCT is still working through the Approach for Developing Soil Gas Action Levels for Vapor Intrusion at Hunters Point Shipyard, we would like to hold off on making any final decisions for the soil gas at Parcels D-1 and G.
