Dear Mr. Feldman:

This is in reply to your letter of December 12, 1990 to the Commanding Officer of Naval Station, Treasure Island regarding Installation Restoration site number three (Oil Ponds) at the Hunters Point Annex (HPA).

As discussed at our meeting of December 20, 1990 this site is being characterized in accordance with the approved Sampling and Analysis Plan. In response to the conditions encountered in the field, the oil observed in the well was sampled and preliminary analytical results provided to you at the above meeting.

The Navy plans to continue to characterize this site and to investigate the extent of soil saturation at the oil reclamation ponds. In furtherance of this effort, we will bail each well weekly for three weeks. After three weeks, the recovery of product will be evaluated and recommendations for consideration of remedial alternatives will be made. If poor product recovery is observed, it is anticipated that remediation would be deferred until the feasibility study is complete. If product recovery is good, then interim remedial options would be considered.

The oil produced by the bailing will require disposal or treatment as hazardous waste because it contains Aroclor 1260 at 84 parts per million.
