**HUNTERS POINT SHIPYARD**  
 Final Record of Decision for Parcel C  
 October 2010

The Department of the Navy announces that the Final Record of Decision (ROD) for Parcel C has been signed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The ROD describes the remedial actions selected for soil, groundwater, and structures at Parcel C. The remedial actions in the ROD include (1) excavation and off-site disposal, soil vapor extraction, and durable covers for soil, (2) treatment with zero-valent iron or a biological substrate, and monitored natural attenuation for groundwater, and (3) decontamination of buildings, removal of storm drains and sewer lines, and excavation of soil to address radiologically impacted structures and soil. Institutional controls will be used parcel-wide to limit exposure of future property users to environmental contamination and to protect the integrity of the remedial actions. The ROD contains public comments received during the public comment period in February 2009 on the Proposed Plan for the remedy as well as the Navy's responses to the comments.
