**DHS RESPONSE TO THE REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF DEADLINES FOR
DELIVERABLES UNDER THE FFA FOR HUNTERS POINT ANNEX**

On June 11, 1991, the Department of Health Services (DHS) received your request for extensions of deadlines for submitting the Summary of Findings Memoranda (SOFM) for Operable Units (OUs) I, III, and IV, and for the Site Investigation (SI) Report for PA-16 and PA-18, for Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex. In addition, you stated that if all of the extensions are granted, all primary document deadlines following the SOFM for OUs I, III, and IV, as well as the SI Report for PA-16 and PA-18, would be adjusted accordingly.


Pursuant to Section 9.4 of the Federal Facility Agreement, the DHS does not concur with your request for the above referenced deadline extensions for the following reasons:

- * The revised due dates for delivery of the SOFM listed in the summary matrix (paragraph 2) do not correspond to the due dates marked on the attached bar graphs, which depict the extensions requested.
- * The revised deadlines requested for delivery of the subsequent primary documents are not listed.
- * The information provided is insufficient for us to assess the appropriateness of the time allotted to the various segments of the tasks to be performed, as depicted on the attached bar graphs.
