The U.S. Navy has reviewed your letter of August 30, 1991 requesting a two week extension of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) prescribed deadline for completion of your review of the draft final Environmental Sampling and Analysis Plan (ESAP). Based on the information presented in your letter and as discussed by you and Mr. Richard Powell of this office on August 30, 1991, the Navy hereby grants your extension request.

We agree with your determination that this extension does not appear to cause any related schedule to be affected. However, we reserve our right to reassess this determination, and to request any appropriate extension(s), in the event that future developments reveal that the extension here at issue, impacts on an existing timetable, extension or schedule.

Of more immediate concern is the completion of the contracting actions necessary to fund implementation of the ESAP. This contracting effort must be completed no later than September 30, 1991. Failure to meet this date would mean that the work could not be awarded until funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 1992 were received by this Command.
