1. In accordance with Section 7.2(a) of the Naval Station, Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), the subject Draft Final Work Plan for PA-18 (as a primary document) becomes *the* Final Work Plan if dispute resolution is not invoked within 30 days after its issuance. The letter of Reference (a) transmitted such an invocation of dispute resolution from the Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC). In response, the Navy initiated informal discussion with representatives of EPA, DTSC, and the Regional Board. Point-by-point responses to the agencies' comments on the Draft Final document were distributed to the agencies via facsimile transmission. Informal resolution of this dispute was concluded by DTSC accepting the comments as being adequate in addressing the concerns indicated by their dispute letter. Enclosure (1) formally transmits the Navy's response to comments and is to be attached to the Draft Final Workplan as an addendum. Consequently, this response to comments, in conjunction with the draft document will constitute the Final Site Inspections: Sites PA-16 and PA-18 And Remedial Investigation Work Plan: Site PA-18.
