Dear Mr. Lum:

This letter will confirm your phone conversation of 24 March 1993 with Mr. William Radzevich of this office, during which the discussion concerned the project to remove or close twenty-three (23) Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) at the Naval Station Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex, San Francisco, California. The field work for these removals and closures will be performed by the Navy Public Works Center, San Francisco Bay (NPWCSF), and their schedule for this project, enclosure (1), shows the work starting in mid-April 1993 and continuing into September 1993. As indicated during the discussion, San Francisco Department of Public Health UST closure approvals are normally valid for ninety (90) days from the date of issuance, and pursuant to your suggestion we are requesting that the requirement to complete the work in 90-days be waived for this project.

As you requested, we have also included enclosure (2), which is a copy of the Final Summary Report of UST Removals (July through October 1991-Phase I), Naval Station Treasure Island, Hunters Point Annex, San Francisco, California, November 18, 1992.
