HUNTERS POINT ANNEX (HPA) ACCELERATED CLEANUP

The full scale proposed removal actions will commence when contractual procedures, funding procurement, and the treatability studies and requirements are accomplished. Judging the previous removal actions at Hunters Point, this process will take three to four years. This is contrary to the expedited cleanup initiatives. The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) strongly believes that an attempt must be made to streamline the process more efficiently. The Department considers an evaluation of current process an imperative step to the expedited cleanup approach. The Department hereby invites all the parties to participate in a strategic meeting at earnest to map out this and other removal actions at the site.
