The above document was received in our office on Sept 18, 1991 and the staff of the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (SFRWQCB) has completed its review. Presented below are general comments that should be considered.

1. It should be noted that the State Water Resources Control Board considers all groundwater aquifers with TDS of 3,000 ppm or less and production capacity of 200 gallons per day or more, as potential sources of drinking water.
2. p. 20, Section 4.2: Does the proposed scenario account for potential exposure due to activities such as gardening or physical contact with soil during home repair or maintenance?
