HUNTERS POINT ANNEX PARCEL C DATA PRESENTATION

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) is forwarding comments on the Parcel C data presentation (8/31/93). The Department is encouraged that accelerated initiatives incorporated by all parties are being beneficial and productive. The Department would like to continue the current format for other portions of cleanup investigation. The Regional Water Quality Control Board has no comment at this time.

1. The Department believes that there should be groundrules in conducting investigation by excavation. These groundrules need not be elaborate, but inclusive and to the point. For example, there should be an established criteria when, how, and to what degree risk assessment results would necessitate an excavation. Future land use scenarios are to be also identified before undertaking any removals. Furthermore, when does an excavation become removal? How does the Navy differentiate the two? These are the important components of the criteria.
2. In managing the excavated soils, storage and disposal requirements must be incorporated. Large scale soil removals are to address and mitigate areas of impact such as local traffic, noise and pollution.
3. Any preliminary assessment sites recommended for further actions must roll into the IR program.
