In a February 2, 1994, letter to you regarding the Hunters Point Annex (HPA) Parcel-A dispute issues, we discussed the current status of the disputed items, and one of these was the storm sewer sediments. The Navy's decision was to eliminate the sediments from the system, and a maintenance cleanout of the Parcel-A storm drains was started on March 31, 1994. The storm drain system will be monitored during and after the cleanout.

Provided for your reference is enclosure (1), which is a work plan for the monitoring of the storm drain system during and after the cleaning. Based on this plan of action, we expect that the sewer sediments are no longer an item of dispute.

We will continue to coordinate with yourself and with Mr. Cyrus Shabahari of the State of California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control, and we are grateful for the significant effort contributed to the resolution of these issues by the regulatory agency's representatives.
