1. As a tool to implement President Clinton's Five-Part Program to promote early reuse of closing bases by expediting the environmental cleanup, a BCP for HPA San Francisco, CA, has been prepared by this Command and is forwarded for your information and use as enclosure (1). By an earlier correspondence, the BCP has been forwarded to the major claimant for the activity and to the Naval Facilities Engineering Command for further endorsement through the chain of command to the Office of the Secretary of Defense.

2. The BCP is the result of a "bottom-up" review of the environmental programs conducted by the BRAC Cleanup Team (BCT) formed for the installation. The BCT consists of Mr. Raymond Ramos, the Navy BRAC Environmental Coordinator (BEC); Ms. Alydda Mangelsdorf, a representative from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Mr. Cyrus Shabahari, from the California Environmental Protection Agency, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC). Other project team members, as identified in the BCP, made contributions toward its development. PRC Environmental Management, Inc. was contracted by this Command to prepare the document.

3. This is the initial submittal of the BCP. As it is intended to be a living document, the BCP will be updated periodically and identified by its date of preparation. Accordingly, enclosure (1) is referred to as the March 1994 BCP. It is anticipated that future submittals will only involve the issuance of the sections being modified.

4. I thank you for your participation and support in implementing the President's fast-track cleanup initiative and look forward to continually working with you on the environmental cleanup.
