**IDENTIFICATION OF STATE ARARS FOR THE PROPOSED FOUR REMOVAL ACTIONS LETTER, HUNTERS POINT ANNEX**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) has evaluated the above letter. The Department has further discussed the issues with the Navy in the RPM meeting on September 14, 1995. As the result, the Department believes that detailed and specific ARARs cannot be identified at this time, when the nature of the remedies are unknown. However to assist and guide the Navy, the Department can identify Chapters 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, 21, 31, and 45 of Title 22 at this time. Also ARARs from the Regional Water Board have been already forwarded to you in more detail. General ARARs from other state agencies have been already forwarded to you. The Department hopes that with the development of each EE/CA, state agencies will be able to assist the Navy with more specific ARARs.
