



U.S. Navy Announces Updated Cleanup Plan for Parcel B at Hunters Point Shipyard

The Navy is announcing completion of its updated cleanup plan for Parcel B at Hunters Point Shipyard in San Francisco, California. The updated plan is presented in a final explanation of significant differences (ESD) to the record of decision (ROD) for Parcel B, as signed by the Navy on May 4, 2000. The ESD describes how the Navy updated its soil cleanup levels in accordance with revised guidelines established by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and an updated background level for nickel. The final ESD is available at: The Anna E. Waden Branch Library located at 5075 Third Street in San Francisco and the City of San Francisco's Main Library located at 100 Larkin Street.
