Subj: PRELIMINARY SITE INVESTIGATION ON DEFENSE  
REUTILIZATION AND MATERIALS OFFICE (DRMO)

Ref: (a) Your ltr DRMS-HW of 17 Oct 91

1. In response to reference (a), the following is provided:

a. Is there a schedule for testing? Restoration?

The site investigation report is expected in October 1992; then Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Studies will take approximately two years; then Remedial Actions could take many years.

b. Does "Site 6" reflect priority or an anticipated level of contamination?

The number "6" is an unprioritized index number used only to distinguish the site from other numerically labelled sites.

c. If there is "high probability" of contamination, are DRMO employees at risk?

Determination of any health risk from soil contamination if confirmed will be made during the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study phase of the Installation Restoration Program described in above item 1.a.

d. Can we pursue projects which do not entail excavation, e.g., repair/upgrade to interior/exterior of existing structures?

There is no problem in pursuing projects as long as they do not involve disturbing the underground integrity as it presently exists.
