As discussed at our September 6, 1993 meeting on the Site 6A Removal Site Evaluation Plan, the proposed routing of the temporary Seaside Avenue detour will extend into Site 6B boundaries. We believe no environmental investigation related to the detour construction on Site 6B will be necessary because construction operations for the detour will not penetrate the asphalt pavement that covers Site 6B. It is planned to lay the detour base and pavement over the existing 6B pavement.

It is requested you review the above and advise whether you concur.
