Dear Mr. Aréllano,

On October 20th we forwarded a letter to Mr. O'Rourke requesting comments on our plan to relocate the Defense Reutilization Management Office (DRMO) Scrap Yard from Naval Station Long Beach Installation Restoration Site 6A to the Long Beach Naval Shipyard Installation Restoration Site 12. There have been several discussions between my staff and your office concerning this issue, however a final resolution has not been reached. Concerns have been raised over trenching of the proposed sewer line, foundation work and the ability to provide unrestricted sampling access during the upcoming RI/FS. Based upon recent discussion between Lieutenant Commander Kevin Barre and Maria Gillette/Alvaro Gutierrez it appears the most expedient method to reach conclusion on the relocation is to have a meeting with all concerned parties from your office, the Naval Station and the Naval Shipyard. From initial attempts to coordinate schedules, the best time for this meeting is December 17, 1993 at 1:00 PM second floor Building 1, Naval Station, Facilities Conference Room 266.

As you are aware we are attempting to expedite the Site 6A clean-up to the extent necessary to support the Port of Los Angeles' Pier 300 project. The February 94 completion for relocation of the DRMO Scrap Yard is an integral part of the pier 300 project execution time line. The goal of the meeting is to openly discuss the details of the DRMO relocation project, address all concerns over the site utilization and suggest alternatives to the present relocation project configuration to satisfy mutual station and DTSC requirements. Please confirm your availability to attend with Mr. Duane Rollefson at (310) 547-7086.
