RCRA CORRECTIVE ACTION/UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS: LONG BEACH  
 NAVAL SHIPYARD AND LONG BEACH NAVAL STATION (LONG BEACH NAVAL  
 COMPLEX) (EPA ID NO. CA6170023109)

This letter is a follow-up to the Department of Toxic  
 Substances Control's (Department) letter of September 21, 1992  
 regarding the underground storage tanks (USTs) at the Long Beach  
 Naval Complex (LBNC).

The Department understands that USTs are currently being  
 removed throughout the LBNC under authority of various local  
 agencies. In conjunction with our September 21, 1992 letter, the  
 Department is requesting information regarding all USTs that were  
 known to have, or found to have had a release. Specifically, the  
 Department requires a map showing the location of all subject  
 USTs and information as to the estimated quantity, lateral and  
 vertical extent, and description of any constituents released.  
 Additional information pertaining to the proposed further  
 characterization and remediation of any releases must also be  
 provided. Copies of UST removal and/or release characterization  
 reports prepared for the appropriate local agency may suffice for  
 this requirement.

Please submit the requested information, on all USTs removed  
 prior to December 31, 1992, to our office within thirty (30) days  
of receipt of this letter. For USTs which may be removed after  
 January 1, 1993, a report detailing the required information must  
 be submitted to the Department within thirty (30) days of the end  
 of each month in which UST releases were identified (e.g. for UST  
 releases identified in January, a report must be submitted prior  
 to March 2, 1993. ←




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The Department will evaluate this information and make a determination as to whether or not any of these releases should be recommended for further investigation under the on-going RCRA corrective action program at LBNC. Alternatively, the Department may defer the clean-up of the releases to the appropriate local agency.
