Administrative Issues

The RAB meeting minutes of April 18, 1995 were approved as written. Ms. Ulaszewski reminded the attendees that *"The sign-in sheet is the official record of attendance for each RAB meeting. If you do not sign in, you did not attend the meeting."*

Donna DiRocco, Community Co-Chair, was not able to attend this meeting as she is away on business.

Ms. Ulaszewski announced that Angel Perea has submitted his resignation from the RAB as his participation conflicted with his work obligations. In addition, a letter has been sent to Joy Baggish regarding her six consecutive absences from the RAB meetings. As stated in the RAB Rules of Operation, once a member misses two consecutive meetings, the RAB member may be asked to resign. Each RAB member situation is reviewed on an individual basis.

Administrative Issues (continued)

The four RAB review committees received copies of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study reports for review and comment at this June RAB meeting.

Response to Comments - Draft 6B Site Inspection Report

The draft responses to RAB comments on the draft 6B Site Inspection Report were presented to the RAB. The RAB has an opportunity to review these draft responses to determine if their comments have been adequately addressed. The final approval of these response to comments will be discussed at the July 18, 1995 RAB meeting.

Comments from U.S. EPA, Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) on the draft 6B document were distributed to the RAB for their review. The Navy is currently working together with these regulatory agencies to arrive at a resolution. The RAB will have an opportunity to review these comments with the regulatory agencies at the July 18, 1995 RAB meeting.

Wendy Phillips, Associate Engineering Geologist with the RWQCB, presented a brief summary of the contents of the Water Quality Control Plan/Basin Plan for the Los Angeles Region. This Plan is designed to preserve and enhance water quality and protect the beneficial uses of all regional waters. Specifically, the Basin Plan designates beneficial uses for surface and ground waters, sets narrative and numerical objectives that must be attained or maintained to protect the designated beneficial uses and conform to the state's antidegradation policy, and describes implementation programs to protect all waters in the Region. In addition, the Basin Plan incorporates (by reference) all applicable State and Regional board plans and policies and other pertinent water quality policies and regulations.

Workshop - Technical Memo #2

Susan Livenick, BNI representative, presented the status of the environmental investigations being performed for IR Sites 8-13 located in the Long Beach Naval Shipyard.

Copies of this Technical Memorandum were distributed to the RAB for information only.

Workshop - Technical Memo #6

Omer Kadaster, BNI representative, presented the status of the environmental investigation being performed for IR Site 7, the Long Beach Harbor (West Basin).

Administrative Issues

The RAB meeting minutes of June 20, 1995 were approved with the following minor amendments (1) Page Two, fourth paragraph, third line, change "an" to "and"; and (2) Alvin Samala was present at the June 20, 1995 meeting, not absent. The RAB members were reminded that *"The sign-in sheet is the official record of attendance for each RAB meeting. If you do not sign in, you did not attend the meeting."*

The RAB discussed the recent resignation of Angel Perea and Joy Baggish and whether or not there was a need to replace these individuals. The RAB agreed that there is no need to look for replacement members unless the community diversity is impacted by a resignation. The RAB membership is currently 24 members, including the regulatory agency representatives, and is believed to represent community diversity at this time.

Response to Comments - Draft 6B Site Inspection Report

The RAB agreed to approve the draft responses to comments on the draft 6B Site Inspection Report, contingent upon receipt and review of comments not included from Donna DiRocco. Revised draft Response to Comments will be prepared, including Ms. DiRocco's comments, and submitted to the RAB in the mailout package for the September 19, 1995 meeting.

Workshop - Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study for IR Program Sites 1-6A

Ed Morelan, BNI Contract Task Order Leader (CTOL), presented the environmental investigation effort and findings for IRP Sites 1-6A located on the former Naval Station Long Beach.

The four RAB Group Leaders will prepare their comments and submit them to Donna DiRocco, the Community Co-Chair by August 17, 1995. The Community Co-Chair will then submit the comment package to the Navy via the BNI Technical Support contact Kathy C. Stevens. The draft Response to Comments will be submitted to the RAB at the September 19, 1995 meeting.

Open Meeting to RAB Members and Members of the Audience

Karl Tidemann announced that the Information Repository at the former Naval Station Library was just recently closed. The BNI Technical Support was given the action to investigate the closure and contact California State University Long Beach about the possibility of maintaining our IR Program documents in their facility. The Long Beach Public Library continues to house IR program documents for review by the RAB and public.

Donna DiRocco asked the RAB how they were reaching the community with information about the Long Beach environmental restoration activities. The RAB members responded by discussing their perceived role and representation on the board. Several members indicated a concern that the message may not be reaching the entire community. Although the Navy publishes a Public Notice for each RAB meeting, John Ryan, Long Beach Naval Shipyard Public Affairs Officer, volunteered to prepare press releases for the local news media to attempt to get additional coverage on the progress of the environmental restoration activities at Long Beach.

The Chair asked the RAB for input regarding the current document review workload, vacation schedules, and the future meeting agenda items. A proposal to postpone the August RAB meeting agenda items until September 19 was discussed and agreed to. **As a result the previously scheduled August 15, 1995 RAB meeting has been cancelled and the next RAB meeting will be September 19, 1995.**
